


## Year 6 Holiday Project

- Write a book review to go on the website
- Summarise the story into a series of pictures for display.
- Create a factfile about Judith Kerr.

You can do any of these things on paper or j2e. Fantastic work will be awarded a pink rabbit! Here are some tips for your project:



## Features of a good book review:

- 1. A summary of the story including:
  - a. Your favourite part
  - b. A part that made you worried about the main character
  - c. A part that made you laugh
- 2. Comments on any characters you particularly liked and why. Were there any characters you disliked and why?
- 3. Who you would recommend the book to and why. What ages and interests is this book suitable for?
- 4. How many stars would you give the book?

## Factfile about Judith Kerr-

If you choose to write about Judith Kerr for your project, you might like to include information about:

- Where she was born, why and when she left.
- Her family
- When she came to Britain and her experiences here
- Her most famous books: The Tiger who came to tea; the Mog series; and When Hitler Stole Pint Rabbit.
- Things that were important to her and her outlook on life.

Judith talks about her life at the back of When Hitler Stole Pink Rabbit- this would be a good place to start your research.
