### Dear Parents,

Welcome back, we have had an excellent start to the year. We had some very good news in the summer holidays, 9 of our Year 6 pupils received their excellent **GCSE results in mathematics**. Congratulations to all of them for this tremendous achievement. We look forward to seeing them all at their award ceremony later in the autumn term.

So far it's been a busy start to the term. Many of our children have already been on a **school trip**. Year 2 children have visited The Brighouse in Atherstone, Year 5 children visited the Black Country Museum as part of their topic on the Victorians in the Midlands and Year 6 went to Manchester to the Imperial War Museum and The Lowry Gallery. Educational visits at Grove are a great success, with opportunities to learn first-hand about fossils, the Victorians and their legacy in the Midlands and life during war time Britain. It's always a proud moment when members of the public comment on how well behaved our pupils are, staff have had many compliments so far this year.

The **school attendance letter** has been sent to all parents on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2018. A copy of this letter is on our school website. School attendance for 2017-2018 was 95%. It is so important that our children attend school regularly. A big congratulations to the 35 children who achieved 100% attendance last year. I hope they all enjoyed their prizes. We will continue to reward good attendance each term with badges, certificates and prizes.

At Grove many children have good attendance, there are just a few children who are persistently absent mainly due to family holidays taken in term time. As you know school does not agree to any family taking their child out of school in term time. From September 2017 to June 2018 school have actioned 68 penalty notices with Birmingham City Council. This is 34 individual children and 23 families. Three families were prosecuted in the Birmingham Magistrates Court for leave in term time, with one family being fined a total of £1031. Please ensure that holidays are booked during the school holidays. I've listed all the holiday dates for you in this letter to help you plan for this.

Staff look forward to sharing with you your child's progress this half term, **parents' evening** is on Thursday 11th October 4:00pm – 6:30pm. If you have ideas on how we can develop our school website to communicate with you, please share your ideas with us at parents' evening.

**School councillors** have been elected, they will be working with their classes to update our anti-bullying policy. Thank you to all the pupils who put themselves forward to be school councillors, they are certainly great ambassadors for our school.

**Keeping children safe on the internet** at home is something that I know concerns many parents have concerns. In November we will have a focused week of work during 12-16<sup>th</sup> November 2018 on anti-bullying. The theme of the anti-bullying week will be **'Choose Respect**.'
