Book week at Grove

This week we were privileged to welcome Hiba Noor Khan to Grove. Hiba is a scientist and author who joined the children in assemblies and at story time. In class pupils have been sharing the books she has written:

Reception, Years 1 and 2 read 'The Little War Cat'

Years 3 and 4 read 'How to Spaghettify Your Dog'

Years 5 and 6 read 'Safiyyah's War'

Hiba talked to the children about: her love for writing stories which began when she was 8 years old; how she creates her stories; and how the children can use a monocle to create stories based on ordinary, daily events. Hiba worked with the children to create their own characters and has inspired many children to begin writing their own stories.

Today the children enjoyed dressing as a character from a book and all made head bands to reveal their favourite book cover or character from a book.

Learning to read is a skill for life. Thank you to parents who read at home and encourage our children to develop a love of reading.
