Over the half term holidays,  
we invite you to go on an autumn walk.

Look for clues such as leaves falling off the trees, berries on the bushes, pine cones, conkers and acorns on the ground. Look for some animals and birds, remember to be very quiet! Look under stones and turn over leaves to see if there are any little creatures there. Talk to your child about the need to be gentle and not to frighten or hurt them.

Can you find any autumn treasures such as  
leaves, conkers or pine cones?



Use mathematical vocabulary to compare the size of the leaves such as; small, smallest, big, biggest, large, tiny, little. Can you think of any more words to describe the size of the objects you find?

Order the leaves smallest to the largest.  
Are all the leaves the same shape or colour?  
Can you sort the leaves into groups?
