I can create a colour wheel

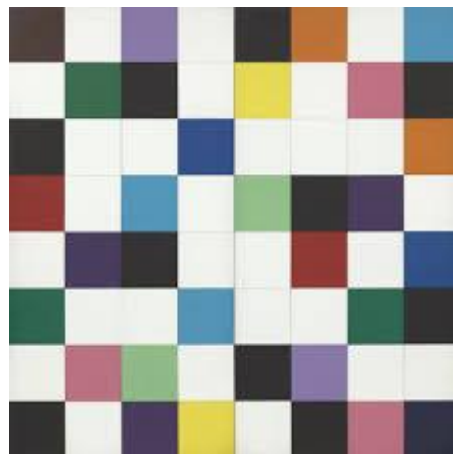
I can make vertical and horizontal brushstrokes
