In printing I have already learnt to:

Explore collagraphy using found objects from the indoor and outdoor environment.
Explore using different media; bubble wrap, natural and manmade sponges, cotton tips, cotton wool,
Observe and describe the effects these media make when printing.

Art words I have learnt:

observe, select, media, print, press, effect, best suited, shape, rotate, next to, in line, below, above, primary colours, tint, shade

I can use a range of natural and manmade objects to **stamp** and **press** onto paper (spools, vegetables, leaves, sponge, crushed paper, corks, flowers, bottle tops)

I can experiment with the amount of paint used to make a print.

I can make prints of a range of colours using a range of objects.

I can make **printing blocks** by drawing and pressing into plasticine, clay, potatoes or polystyrene

I can print on paper, card and fabric.

I can make a simple pattern using a single object or block.

I can make a pattern using 2 blocks and two colours.

I can make a **monoprint**.
