In drawing I have already learnt to:

Observe and describe different types of lines

Draw different types of lines, straight, curved, wavy, thick, thin, broken, zig-zag

Draw spirals

Hold the pencil close to the point for control and detail

Know that refining lines makes them more accurate

Draw objects from observation

Know that pencils have different grades. HB is used for writing and sketching.

Add shade

Art words I have learnt:

Straight, curved, wavy, broken, zig-zag, investigate, light/dark lines, observe, explore, describe

I can use **HB** pencils and **4B** pencils.

I know that holding the pencil close to the point will help control and detail, further towards the end creates loose sketching.

I can follow basic **contours** and **outlines** of shapes from observation using a guide with a hand or viewfinder.

I know that refining lines increases the accuracy of their drawing.

I understand that **directional shading** is moving the pencil back and forth using contour lines (a shape's outer line) as a guide.

I can add **shade** using overlapping

I can draw **patterns**

I can create **lighter and darker** lines by pressing **harder and softer**
