 I can **list the negative feelings** that can result from **not forgiving others**.

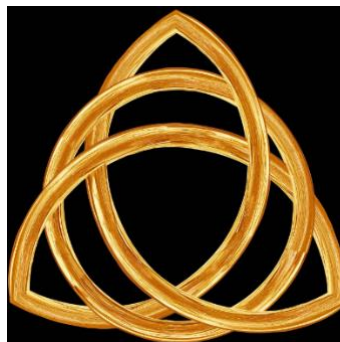
